Now for something completely different...

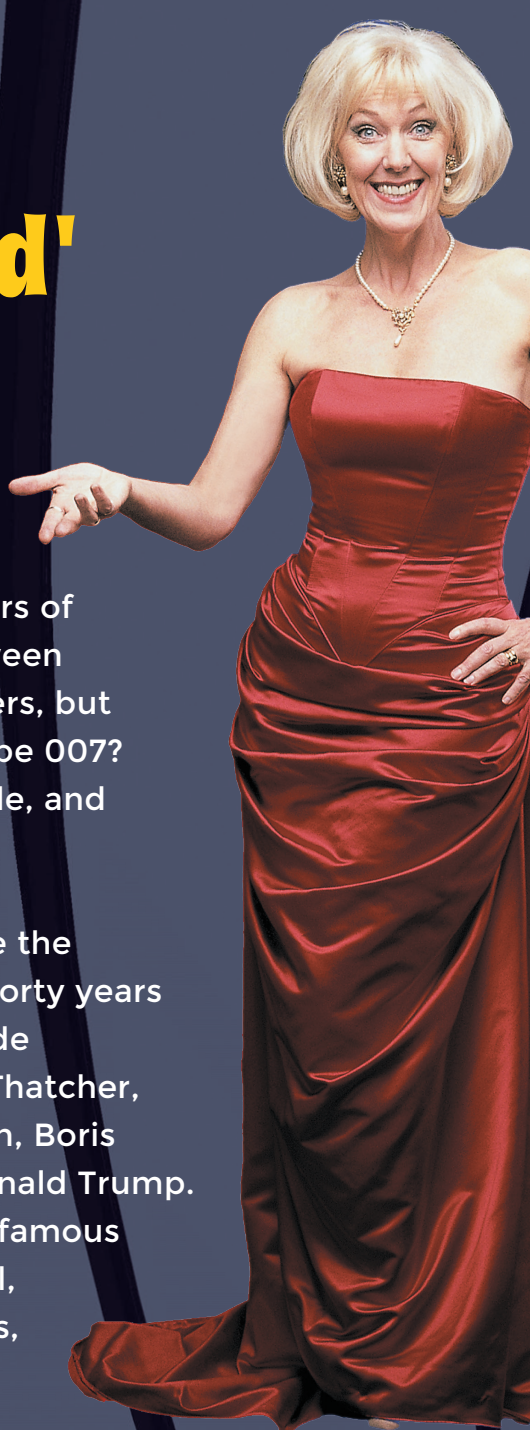

Vivienne McKee

Vivienne founded the London Toast Theatre in 1982, and this is the 41st Crazy Christmas Show she has written, directed and starred in.

Last year she received outstanding reviews and was voted "Best Actress" for her portrayal of "Shirley Valentine" at Teatret ved Sorte Hest. She also writes plays: including "Oh Baby - It's Cole", based on the life of Cole Porter, "Don't Mention Hemingway" about the first female war correspondent, Martha Gellhorn, and "Shakespeare's Ghost".

Her film and TV credits include the popular movie musical, "The Slipper and the Rose", and TV soaps, "Coronation Street" and "Crossroads". In Denmark, TV series include "Langt fra Las Vegas", "Smil du er På", and "Ørnen". Danish films include "Mødre Gruppen", Stranger Within, and on stage, "Young Frankenstein - The Musical" and Gertrude in "Hamlet" at the Shakespeare Festival in Elsinore.

Her voice-over work includes the role of Diana Burnwood in 3 seasons of the worldwide video game "Hitman" and she is the English voice on Denmark's Intercity trains.

She is also a popular Stand Up comedian with her shows, "Vivienne Tells All" and "Killing the Danes". Vivienne would like everyone to know that her extensive talent is open to all offers :-))

Kevin Kiernan - Molloy



Kevin is Australian and lives in Denmark.

He graduated from the Victorian College of the Arts in 2010. His theatre credits in Copenhagen include, "Shakespearean Ghost" (London Toast), "Much Ado About Nothing" and "A Midsummer Nights Dream" (After Hours Theatre), "Mairead" and "The Art of Falling" (Why Not Theatre) and "No Exit: Reloaded" - (HIT).

Kevin's work in film and TV is predominantly in Australia but since moving to Europe he has worked in Ireland, Greece, the UK and Canada.

In 2019 Kevin lost his Crazy Christmas virginity in the "The Three Brexiteers" notably as crazy King Louis and ready for more fun this year for his 5th Crazy Christmas!

This is Katrine's 00-16th Crazy Christmas Show. And she doesn't look a day older..right?!? This year her dream of playing a bond babe comes true multiple times. She can't wait jumping in and out of hot costumes and juggling with various accents.

She graduated from the Royal Academy of Music in London in 2004 and enjoyed being backing singer for Sir Elton John on a UK tour before she returned to Denmark.

She has appeared in numerous musicals, shows, bands and concerts across Denmark since 1995.

Over the last 23 years she has had a very successful voice-over career, including commercials, corporate videos and playing hundreds of cartoon characters.

You can hear her guiding voice every day in the depth of the Copenhagen Metro. You might also have spotted her in various TV-commercials and series.

David has played many characters in Crazy Xmas Shows over the years, including James Bond, Dracula, Angela Merkel, Gunther von Hinton(!), and even Donald Trump.

This year he is looking forward to slipping into Elon Musk...!

He also plays the conductor of DR's Symphony Orchestra in DR's comedy award-winning TV series "Orkestret". He regularly appears in DR's Koncerthuset theme concert series as a narrator, most recently celebrating music scores of science fiction films in Galaxysymphony 3.

David is renowned for his voice-over work worldwide, and has his own sound studio where he records TV commercials, corporate films, audio books, documentaries, film trailers and computer games.

He is the face and the voice of Agent 47 in Denmark's internationally famous computer game "Hitman.", which celebrates its 25th anniversary this year as the World's third most iconic game character, ever.

David also plays Bowser in the Danish version of the Super Mario Bros film.

Sebastian will be doing Freddy in “My Fair lady” at Det Ny Teater in 2026 and will also do Nykøbing Falster Revyen 2026. Besides being on stage, Sebastian works as a voice actor, dubbing characters in various cartoons and live action movies and also commercial speaks for Gillette and LEGO. He is very excited to be back working with the London Toast Theatre in his second Crazy Christmas Cabaret!

Andrew has been an actor for over 30 years and has appeared in various British TV soaps, plays and musicals before moving permanently to Copenhagen. She was awarded the “Revyprisen” for lifetime achievements, and as a unique Director/Designer partnership for 36 years, Kirsten and Vivienne should be in the Guinness Book of Records!

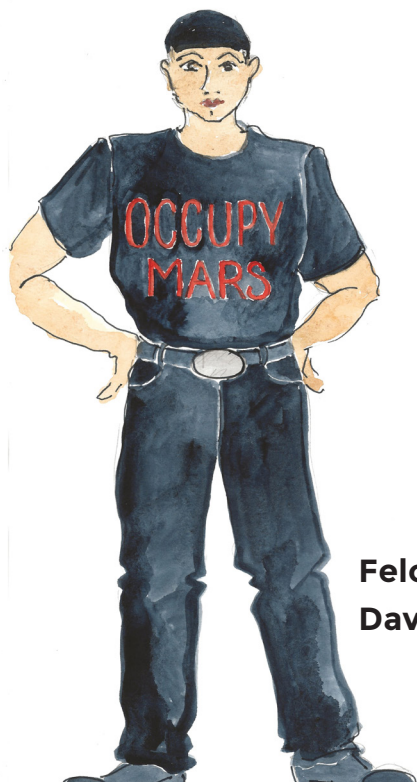

Through the years we have produced theatre other than the Crazy Christmas show.

Our productions of British playwrights like Stephen Berkoff, Tom Stoppard, Alan Ayckbourn, Arnold Wesker, Harold Pinter, Michael Frayn and others have accustomed Danish audiences to appreciate modern English drama in the original language.

We have also tackled the classics like "The Importance of being Earnest" by Oscar Wilde, two Shakespeare plays in the 90'ies: "Macbeth" and "As You Like It" and some years ago we co-produced a very successful production of "Hamlet" at Elsinore Castle for the international Shakespeare Festival.

Most recently we received excellent reviews for Vivienne McKee's "Shakespeare's Ghost" and Willy Russell's "Shirley Valentine" at Teatret ved Sorte Hest and for our Cole Porter cabaret "Oh Baby It's Cole" which played to a sold out audience during the CPH STAGE theatre festival in 2019.
